The United Kingdom is an island that is made up of four countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. It is surrounded by different bodies of water.

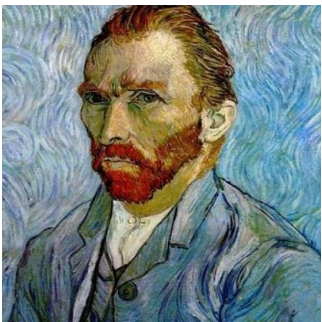
The four seas around the United Kingdom are: The English Channel, North Sea, Atlantic Ocean and the Irish sea.
