The car was invented 70 years after the train.

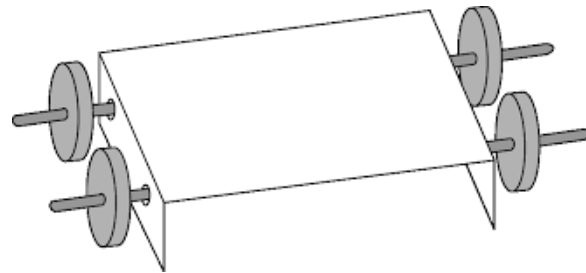
The first car only had enough space for 2 people. It did not have doors or a roof!
